Non-Christian/Seeker (Curious)

Bible

- Go through the KGP blue booklet. Discuss their understanding and discuss the two circles illustration
- Do they have a Bible? Would they like one?
- Go through a discovery Bible study*

Prayer

- Pray daily that God would open their heart (*Acts 16:14*).
- Ask them to pray that as well

Fellowship

- Get involved in a Wide Awake small group
- Invite them to Noondays
- Visit church(es)

Witness

- Read Matthew 9:9-13. Throw a Matthew Party (Wide Awake Small group event, new believer's Bible study, or any custom event where Christians and non-Christians get together)

Notes:

- Evaluate where they are and where they once were on the Engel scale of evangelism* (Do this every few weeks, or when it's appropriate.)
- Suggest a book for them to read: *More Than a Carpenter* by Josh McDowell or *The Reason for God* by Tim Keller
